

# ♥ Valentines Scrappy Heart Pattern ♥

1. Start with a 6 1/2 square piece of muslin fabric.

This will be your foundation for your flip and sew method of piecing.

2. Cut several assorted, pink and red scraps of fabrics, don't be afraid of cutting at an angle.

3. Lay the first fabric down right side up on the muslin block then layer the second fabric wrong side up over the edge of the 1st fabric. Sew a quarter inch seam.

4. Flip fabric up and iron. Continue piecing the scraps till you cover the entire muslin block. Don't be afraid if there is a hole or 2. You will cover that up with a decorative stitch.

5. Flip your block over to the wrong side and trim off all layers of the scraps.

6. Now is your chance to use your sewing machines' decorative stitches! Don't be afraid! Just go for it! The scrappier and more stitches the better.

7. Use the half heart shape pattern and cut it out. Fold your block in half, right sides together and pin the pattern on top. Cut out shape.

8. Vola! Now you have a cute scrappy heart to applique on anything!

Here are some cute ideas:

Potholder, pocket on an apron, a mini quilt for a teapot. Or to set a candle on.
